*The Walk: Share*

● **Begin by reflecting on/sharing a high and/or a low from your week**

● **CONNECT** *with each other*

- When has someone served you most recently? How did it make you feel? Will you try to repay them? If so, how?

● **GROW** *in Christ*

*9 To some who were confident of their own righteousness and looked down on everyone else, Jesus told this parable: 10 “Two men went up to the temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector. 11 The Pharisee stood by himself and prayed: ‘God, I thank you that I am not like other people—robbers, evildoers, adulterers—or even like this tax collector. 12 I fast twice a week and give a tenth of all I get.’*

*13 “But the tax collector stood at a distance. He would not even look up to heaven, but beat his breast and said, ‘God, have mercy on me, a sinner.’*

*14 “I tell you that this man, rather than the other, went home justified before God. For all those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted.”*

### **Luke 18:9-14**

- Share any words or phrases that speak into your life today.
- The tax collector identifies as “a sinner,” how would the Pharisee identify himself?
- Why is humility so important to serving other people?
- Rather than looking down on people who need help, what could your posture be towards them?

● **SERVE** *others*

Ask a person who is having a tough week, “How can I help?”

● **End with Prayer, the Lord's Prayer, or a short Blessing.**
