### **Matthew 6: 19-21 Jesus talks with His disciples about possessions**

<sup>19</sup> “Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. <sup>20</sup> But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. <sup>21</sup> For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

- Share any words or phrases that speak into your life today?
- What do you think Jesus means when He talks about storing up treasures?
- According to Jesus, what are some of the advantages of storing up treasures in heaven rather than on earth?
- What does Jesus say about how our external choices regarding our possessions of time talents and treasures, reflect our internal spiritual condition (verse 21)?
- This sermon series was about the Spiritual Disciplines of: Worship, Share, Serve, Study and Give. It’s fairly clear how the Holy Spirit uses the first 4 to grow our faith and deepen our relationship with God, but how do you think He does that with our Giving?
- Why is Giving so important to our spiritual life?
- **SERVE** *others*

Consider taking on the challenge of doing 5 acts of generosity in the next month. Generosity is defined as: showing a readiness to give more of something, as money or time, than is strictly necessary or expected.
- **End with Prayer, the Lord's Prayer, or a short Blessing.**
