

# Royal Redeemer Going Deeper Guide

Based on the sermon for Sept 26, 2021  
*The Story: The Resurrection*



**For personal reflection or for use as a devotion with CGS Community or family**

- **Begin by reflecting on/sharing a high and/or a low from your week**
- **CONNECT** *with each other*
  - What events or situations in your life have influenced your frame of reference for seeing current situations (i.e. what has reinforced or diminished your ability to trust others).
- **GROW** *in Christ*

## **Read Romans 1: 1-6 (below)**

- 1 Paul, a servant of Christ Jesus, called to be an apostle and set apart for the gospel of God— 2 the gospel he promised beforehand through his prophets in the Holy Scriptures 3 regarding his Son, who as to his earthly life was a descendant of David, 4 and who through the Spirit of holiness was appointed the Son of God in power by his resurrection from the dead: Jesus Christ our Lord. 5 Through him we received grace and apostleship to call all the Gentiles to the obedience that comes from faith for his name's sake. 6 And you also are among those Gentiles who are called to belong to Jesus Christ.
- Share any words or phrases that speak into your life today?
- According to verses 2 & 3 of Romans 1, what was Paul's frame of reference for seeing the resurrection?
- Read Jeremiah 23: 5-6 as an example of the frame of reference through which Paul sees the resurrection and discuss.
- According to verse 4 of Romans 1, what did the resurrection of Jesus prove about Who He was?
- Paul's frame of reference for seeing the resurrection was faith in the words of the prophets he saw lived out in Jesus' life. In a similar way, our frame of reference is faith in the eye witness accounts of Jesus' resurrection in the scriptures. Read John 20: 11-21 and 1 Corinthians 15: 3-8 and discuss how these scriptures support this statement.
- How would you support your belief in the resurrection to someone else?
- **SERVE** *others*  
Prayerfully ask God to put someone on your heart that needs to hear about Jesus resurrection and then give you the words and courage to do that.
- **End with Prayer, the Lord's Prayer, or a short Blessing.**
