Psalm 13 (NIV)

¹How long, Lord? Will you forget me forever? How long will you hide your face from me?
²How long must I wrestle with my thoughts and day after day have sorrow in my heart? How long will my enemy triumph over me? ³Look on me and answer, Lord my God. Give light to my eyes, or I will sleep in death, ⁴and my enemy will say, "I have overcome him," and my foes will rejoice when I fall. ⁵But I trust in your unfailing love; my heart rejoices in your salvation. ⁶I will sing the Lord's praise, for He has been good to me.

- Share any words or phrases that speak into your life today.
- Have you ever experienced the feelings that David is expressing about God? Share the circumstances of the situation with the group.
- Are you surprised at the way David spoke to God in verse 1-3?
- What do you think happened between verses 4 & 5 to change David's perspective?
- How do you think focusing on what you know about God rather than what you don't know about God will help dispel your doubts?

 - Share this insight about expressing your doubts about God with someone.
