

## Royal Redeemer Going Deeper Guide

Based on the sermon for January 3, 2021:  
*The Story: His Story - Your Story*



**For personal reflection or for use as a devotion with CGS Community or family**

- **Begin by reflecting on/sharing a high and/or a low from your week**

- **CONNECT** *with each other*

- Tell the story of something you saw that looked very strange until you understood the context.

- **GROW** *in Christ*

*14 But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom you learned it, 15 and how from infancy you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. 16 All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, 17 so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.*

**2 Timothy 3:14-17**

- Share any words or phrases that speak into your life today.
- Describe your relationship with the Bible on your faith journey as a child, a young adult, and as an adult.
- How well would you say you understand the big picture of the Bible? What people or experiences have helped you most along the way?
- What do you imagine it would take to understand the Bible better than you do today?
- Paul writes that all Scripture is “God-breathed”. How do you understand that phrase?
- How do you understand “righteousness” as Paul uses the word in v. 16 above?
- How are you planning to engage in our congregation’s journey through The Story?

- **SERVE** *others*

Think of at least one person in your life who would benefit from joining this journey through The Story. Perhaps someone who is isolated or who is otherwise struggling now. Pray for them and ask God to show you how to love them in His name. Reach out with an invitation to join the Story -- perhaps delivering a book to them.

- **End with Prayer, the Lord's Prayer, or a short Blessing.**
